APRIL 2018 SWAP STAMP CLASS

- 1. Supplies and instructions given are for my version of the swap.
- **2.** Remember that the DSP, some stamp sets, some ink pads and cardstock colors, and the 1-3/8" punch are are the retiring list. So.... You can either try to order them, or use what you have and make substitutions for what you don't have.
- 3. The Original Swap is pictured on the left. My version is on the right.

CARD 1-CREATIVE EVERY DAY CARD



I did really like the Black & White of the original swap made by Julie Sperman. I did not have the Petal Passion DSP she used. So I changed the DSP and ink colors.

SUPPLIES:

Stamps: Crafting Forever Wood Mount #

Ink: Dapper Denim

Cardstock: Dapper Denim

Whisper White

Eastern Palace Specialty Designer Series Paper (DSP)

#144147

Big Shot: Quilt Top Embossing Folder #144687

Layering Circles Framelits # **Punch:** 1-1/2" Circle #

Embellishments: Night of Navy 3/8" Corduroy Ribbon

#145597

Adhesive: Tombow Glue (Yes, this is all I used! You can add Stampin' Dimensionals if you want.)

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your papers:

- ~Dapper Denim card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
- ~Whisper White card front at 4" x 5-1/4". Run through Big Shot with Quilt Top embossing folder.

- ~DSP at 2-5/8" x 4". (Original was 2-1/4" x 4". I was doing this at night. I must have been tired and got the measurement wrong.)
- ~Dapper Denim Circle: Use the largest smooth Circle Framelit.
- ~Whisper White Circle: Stamp your Pens in Dapper Denim ink on Whisper White cardstock. Cut out with the largest Scallop Circle Framelit. Line up the pen points so they are in a scallop and don't get cut off.
- ~Stamp your sentiment in Dapper Denim ink on Whisper White cardstock. Punch with the 1-1/2" Circle Punch.

2. Put your card together.

- ~Glue your embossed card front onto your card base.
- ~Glue on your DSP.
- ~Glue your two large circles together.
- ~Lay out your circles on your card front. First glue down the punched sentiment, then the larger pen circles.
- ~Cut two 1-1/2" pieces of ribbon. Cut the one end of each at an angle. Glue onto large circle.

Your card is finished.

CARD 2-CENTER FOLD CARD





The Original Swap was made by Sharon Cheng. It took me quite a while to figur out all the measurements and how to get the fold even, as no details were given. This is a fun card to make! Choose any Designer Series Paper you want and coordinating cardstock.

SUPPLIES:

Stamps: Eastern Palace Photopolymer #143675 OR Detailed with Love Wood Mount # Clear Mount #146606 (Available June 1, 2018)

Ink: Tranquil Tide

Cardstock: Thick Whisper White

Whisper White Tranquil Tide

Lemon Lime Twist (Optional)

Naturally Eclectic Designer Series Paper (DSP) #

Punches: 1-3/4" Circle # 1-3/8" Circle # (Optional) Adhesives: Tombow Glue Stampin' Dimensionals

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your Thick Whisper White card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". SCORE and fold at 4-1/4".

2. Card Front:

~Cut Two Tranquil Tide Card Front Layers at 2-5/8" x 4" ~Cut the Folding Template from Cardstock at 1-7/8" x 2-7/16". Trim off one corner as shown in the photo above.

- ~Cut Four DSP rectangles at 1-7/8" x 2-7/16".
- ~Lay out your DSP as you want them on the card front. ~Put the Template on the DSP so the fold will be in the center of the card. Fold the corner. (Yes you can pick up

the DSP to fold it. Just keep the folding corner of the Template in the same position. Otherwise you will have to rearrange your DSP or turn some over and use the DSP back side.

~Glue the two top Folded DSP pieces to one of the Tranquil Tide Card Front Layers making sure the fold are in the center. Glue the last two DSP pieces to the other Tranquil Tide DSP layer again making sure the folds open in the center.

- ~Now lay out the Card Front Layers on the card base. Glue into position.
- 3. Punched Sentiment. Choose your sentiment. Stamp on Whisper White cardstock with Tranquil Tide ink. Punch with one of the Circle Punches. If your sentiment is punched out with the 1-3/8" circle punch then also punch a 1-3/4" Lemon Lime Twist circle. Attach punched sentiment to card front with Stampin' Dimensionals. Your card is finished.

CARD 3-THANK YOU CARD



The person who made this original swap did not put her name or other information on the swap. I did not have the exact DSP she used, so I substituted another one.

SUPPLIES:

Stamps: Thankful Thoughts Wood Mount #

Ink: Memento Black

Old Olive

Cardstock: Calypso Coral

Powder Pink

Petal Garden 6x6 Designer Series Paper Stack #144168

Big Shot: Eastern Medallion Thinlits #143725

INSTRUCTIONS:1. Cut your Papers:

- ~Cut your Calypso Coral card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
- ~Powder Pink Card layer at 4" x 5-1/4".
- ~Calypso Coral layer at 2-1/2" x 4-3/8". Run through Big Shot with the Garden Trellis embossing folder.
- ~DSP layer at 2" x 4".
- ~Whisper White with the large Eastern Medallion Framelit. You will need to cut it from the cardstock at the tips with your Paper Snips. Stamp your sentiment in Memento Black ink in the center. If necessary use either your Stamp-a-ma-jig or Stamparatus to position it perfectly. Sponge around the Medallion edges with Old Olive ink. I wanted a contrast instead of a match.
- ~Might as well cut your Ribbon now too. Cut at 4-1/4". Cut the ends diagonally at the angle you want.

Ribbon: I used one of the Sale-a-bration Ribbons from

the Ribbon Package

Tools: Stamping Sponge **Adhesives:** Tombow Glue

SNAIL

Stampin' Dimensionals

2. Put your card together.

- ~Attach your Powder Pink card layer to your card base.
- ~Lay out the other pieces where you want them.
- ~Glue on your embossed Calypso Coral card layer at an angle.
- ~You can add your ribbon now (like my stampers thought you should) or on top of the DSP Layer. Just run some SNAIL along the back side of the ribbon and attach over the cardstock layers.
- ~Glue on your DSP straight up and down.
- ~Attach your ribbon if you still need to.
- ~Attach your Medallion with Stampin' Dimensionals. Your Card is finished.

CARD 4-BIRTHDAY CARD



The Original Swap was stamped by Marsha (No last name provided). I did not have the same flower stamp set so I chose the retiring Flower Shop stamp set. People choose different flowers from the set for their cards.

SUPPLIES:

Stamps: Flower Shop Wood Mount # Big on Birthdays Photopolymer # Flourishing Phrases Wood Mount #

Ink: Calypso Coral Garden Green

Peekaboo Peach Marker to color in the flowers

Cardstock: Calypso Coral

Peekaboo Peach Whisper White

Adhesives: Tombow Glue OR SNAIL OR Stampin'

Dimensionals

INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your Papers:

~Cut your Calypso Coral card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".

Larger Back Layers:

~Peekaboo Peach: 4" x 5-1/4"

~Whisper White Flower Layer: 3-3/4" x 5"

Sentiment Layers:

~Calypso Coral Layer: 3-1/4" x 3-1/4"

~Whisper White sentiment layer: 3" x 3"

2. Stamp

~Sentiment on 3" x 3" Whisper White in Calypso Coral ink.

~3-3/4" x 5" Whisper White layer: Stamp flowers in Calypso Coral ink. Stamp some off the edges. Make sure you have some stamping to cover about 1-1/2" from both the top and bottom. Stamp the leaves in Garden Green ink in the blank spaces in between the flowers. Color in the flowers, if desired, with your Peekaboo Peach Marker.

3. Attach the Lavers.

I used Tombow for all the Layers. Use the adhesive of your choice. You might want to attach the sentiment layers to the card with Stampin' Dimensionals.

Larger Back Layers:

~Peekaboo Peach: 4" x 5-1/4"

~Whisper White Flower Layer: 3-3/4" x 5"

Sentiment Layers:

~Calypso Coral Layer: 3-1/4" x 3-1/4" ~Whisper White sentiment layer: 3" x 3"

Your card is finished.
