COLORING TOOLS:

You can use Stampin' Write Markers, Stampin' Blends, or Watercolor Pencils. Stampin' Blends were used on Card 1 and Stampin' Write Markers on Card 2. Choose the coloring tools and colors you want. Watercolor Pencils would also be a great choice.

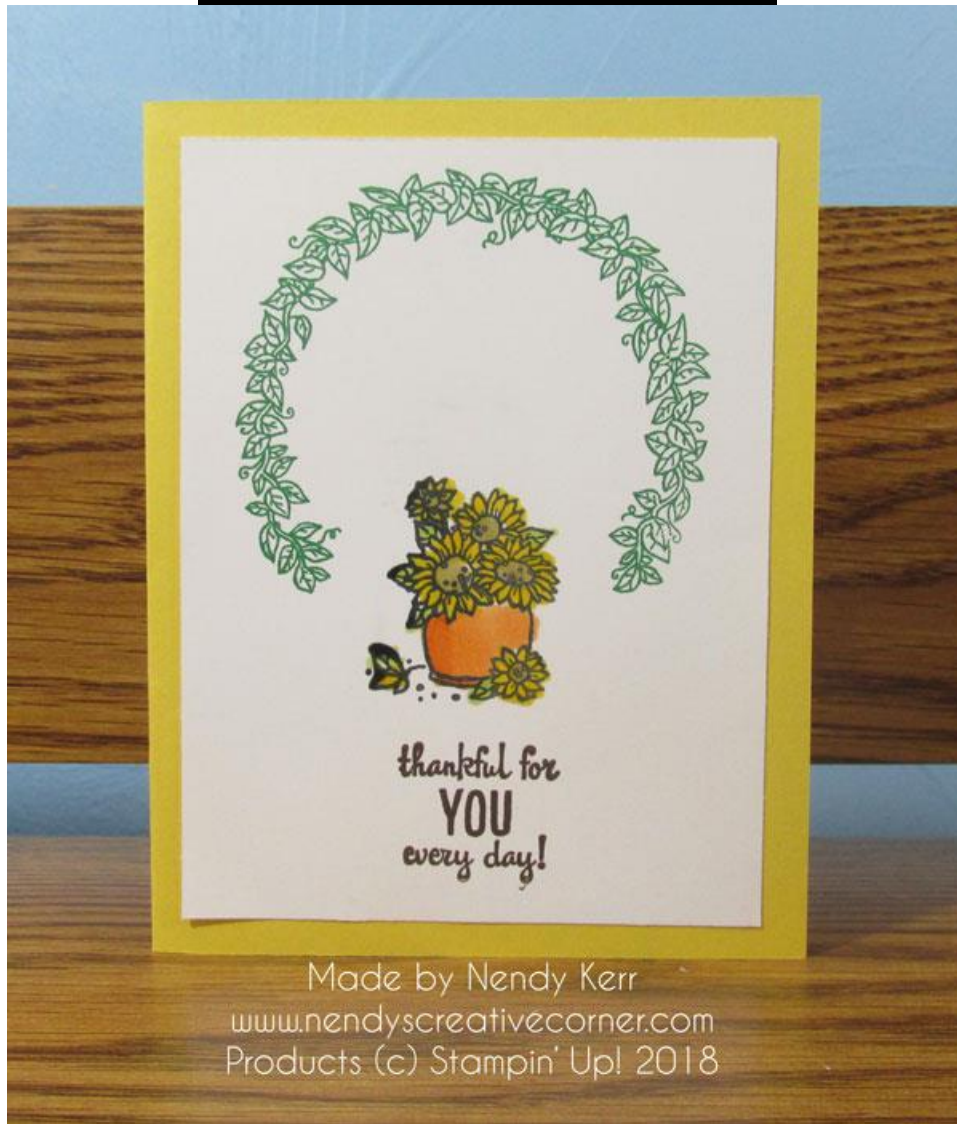

CARD 1-SUNFLOWER CARD

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INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your Daffodil Delight card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
2. Cut your Whisper White card front at 3-3/4" x 5". You will do all your stamping on this piece.
3. **Stamp.**
 - ~Circular Vine in Call Me Clover ink
 - ~Sunflower Vase in Memento Black ink
 - ~Sentiment in Early Espresso ink
 - ~Let your ink air dry or dry with your Heat Tool. This will keep your colors brighter and not so muddy looking.
4. **Color:**

Stampin' Blends colors are given.

 - ~Sunflower petals: Daffodil Delight Dark. (The muddy color was caused by the Black ink smearing into the petals because I was just too excited to start coloring. Make sure your ink is dry before you start coloring.)
 - ~Sunflower centers: Crumb Cake Light
 - ~Leaves: Old Olive Light
 - ~Vase: Color the left side (about 1/4") and a strip along the right side with the Pumpkin Pie Dark. Color and blend the whole vase with Pumpkin Pie Light.
5. Attach card front to card base.

CARD 2-PUMPKINS AND SUNFLOWERS CARD



INSTRUCTIONS:

1. Cut your Pumpkin Pie card base at 5-1/2" x 8-1/2". Score and fold at 4-1/4".
2. Cut your Pumpkin Pie card front at 4" x 5-1/4". Run through the Big Shot with the Subtle Dynamic Embossing Folder. Here is the Sandwich: Big Shot Platform with Thin Die Adapter removed, Embossing Folder with cardstock inside, Top Cutting Plate. Yes, we skipped the bottom cutting plate. Use the Cajun Craze Marker to color the card front edge. Attach to card base.
3. Place your Sunflower stamp and Pumpkin stamp so they are touching on the same Clear Stamp Block. Notice the bottoms of each stamp is not at the same level to give the impression of one being closer and one further away. Stamp with Memento Black ink.
4. **Color:**
Stampin' Write Markers were used. Choose the coloring tools and colors you want. Here is what I used.
~Garden Green for the Sunflower leaves.
~Daffodil Delight for the Sunflower Petals. Again, make sure your Memento Ink is dry before coloring.
~Soft Suede for Sunflower Centers
~Powder Pink for the Vase. I colored the darker parts 2-3 times so it would appear darker.
~Crate: Crumb Cake
~Pumpkins: Pumpkin Pie. I colored the lines on the Pumpkins with Cajun Craze.
~Old Olive: Leaves and stems in Pumpkin area.
~Poppy Parade: Apple
~Gourd: Sahara Sand and Daffodil Delight.
~Ground: Sahara Sand
5. Cut out your colored images with the Oval Stitched Framelit the size you need.
6. Stamp your Sentiment in Early Espresso ink. Cut out with a smaller Stitched Shapes Oval Framelit.
7. Color the edges of both Ovals with the Cajun Craze Marker.
8. Lay out your Ovals on your card front in the positions you want them. Attach the Large Oval with all your coloring with Stampin' Dimensionals. Glue on the smaller Oval with the sentiment.
Your Card is finished.
